PROMOTER'S CONDITIONS

RULES OF ENTRY

- 1 All competitors must be members of a swimming club affiliated to the Wandsworth Borough Swimming Association or from such other Club by special invitation.
- 2 The meet shall be run under ASA Laws and FINA Technical Rules of Swimming.
- 3 In accordance with ASA Child Protection policy, all photographic equipment including mobile phones with cameras must be registered at each gala.
- 4 The age limits for each event in the gala will be as follows:
 - 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m Free: 10 & Over
 - 1500m Free, 800m Free and 400m IM: 11 & overAge is as at **31 December 2016**.
- 5 There shall be separate events for males and females although they will be swum combined.
- 6 This is a Time Trial gala to allow swimmers who are close to the Surrey Qualifying times to achieve a qualifying entry for the Surrey County Championships. As a guide to coaches and swimmers we would suggest that swimmers should be within the following delta of the Surrey Qualifying time to succeed at this gala:
 - 50m: 0.5 secs
 - 100m: 1 sec
 - 200m: 2 sec
 - 400m: 4 sec
 - 800m: 8 sec
 - 1500m: 15 sec
- 7 Entry times will be short course times for the event distance.
- 8 Eligible swimmers should submit their entries through their Clubs using HyTek. The entry fee for each event is £3.
- 9 Entries will be processed electronically using HyTek Team Manager. Entry into this competition implies acceptance that necessary data may be stored electronically.
- 10 The Registration System:
 - Swimmers shall be placed in graduated time order, slowest to fastest. All heats will be spearheaded.
 - Swimmers must check in **during** the published registration period by signing the check in sheet for each event in which they are swimming. A swimmer who is late to register may be placed in an unoccupied lane at the discretion of the meet administrator. If you are delayed in traffic, you should call Alan on 07889 753834 during the registration period.
 - A list of heat and lane assignments will be posted. It is the swimmers responsibility to check the heat sheet and be at the whipping area on time.
 - Five minutes prior to the start of the gala or one event prior to the one in which you are competing, you should present yourself to the Clerk of the Course.
- 11 No medals or trophies will be awarded at this gala.
- 12 If any of the above rules are subsequently found to have been contravened the Promoter shall decide what action if any shall be taken against those concerned.
